Food Show Guidelines:

- Entries will be taken Friday, February 20, 2009 between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. in the Woods County Fairgrounds Kitchen. Judging will begin at 7:30 p.m.
- Recipes used may be taken from the 4-H manual or any other recipe that fits the exhibit.
- All entries should be labeled on the bottom with participant's name and class number.
- Individuals may enter more than one class in their age division, but only one entry in each class.
- All ages will be as of January 1, 2009. **Juniors - ages 9-11, Intermediates - ages 12-14 and Seniors - ages 15 and above.**
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbons and cash awards (\$5.00 for 1st, \$4.00 for 2nd place, and \$3.00 for 3rd place) will be awarded.
- Overall Champions and Reserve Champions will be selected from each age division.
- All items will be priced and offered for sale on Saturday, February 21, to support the Woods County 4-H Parents' and Volunteers' Organization.

Juniors (Age 9-11)

Class 1- Muffins (3 on a plate), sealed with plastic wrap, or baggy

Class 2- Rolled Biscuits (3 on a plate), “ “ “

Class 3- Drop Cookies (3 on a plate), “ “ “

Class 4- Shaped Cookies (3) - peanut butter, snickerdoodles, etc.

Class 5- Fruit Leather (2 pieces)

Intermediates (Age 12-14)

Class 6- Yeast Bread (1/2 loaf), not a sweet dough; make by hand or in a bread machine

Class 7- Yeast Cinnamon Rolls (3 on a plate, no icing)

Class 8- Rolled Cookies (3 on a plate, no icing)

Class 9- Decorated Cupcakes (3 on a plate)

Class 10- Dried Fruit (1/2 cup single fruit)

Seniors (Age 15 and Above)

Class 11- Cake (white or butter type, no icing)

Class 12- Two-crust fruit pie

Class 13- Bread from another culture (include a paragraph about the bread and how it fits in that culture)

Class 14- Decorated cake, any size, on a covered plate or tray

Adult Classes

Class 15- Cake Mix Plus, 1/2 cake, frosted

Class 16- Angel Food Cake, 1/2 cake, no glaze or frosting
